



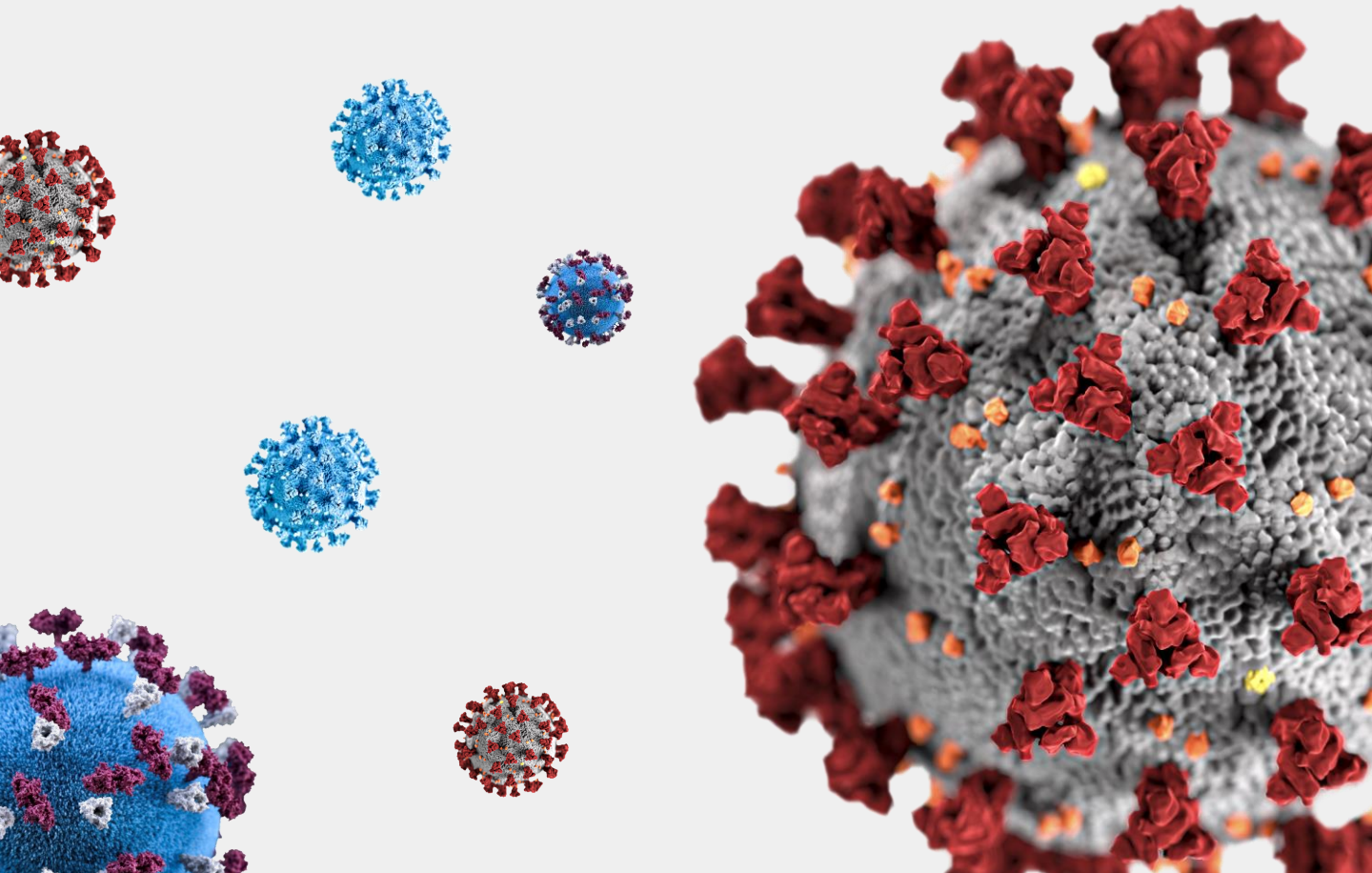

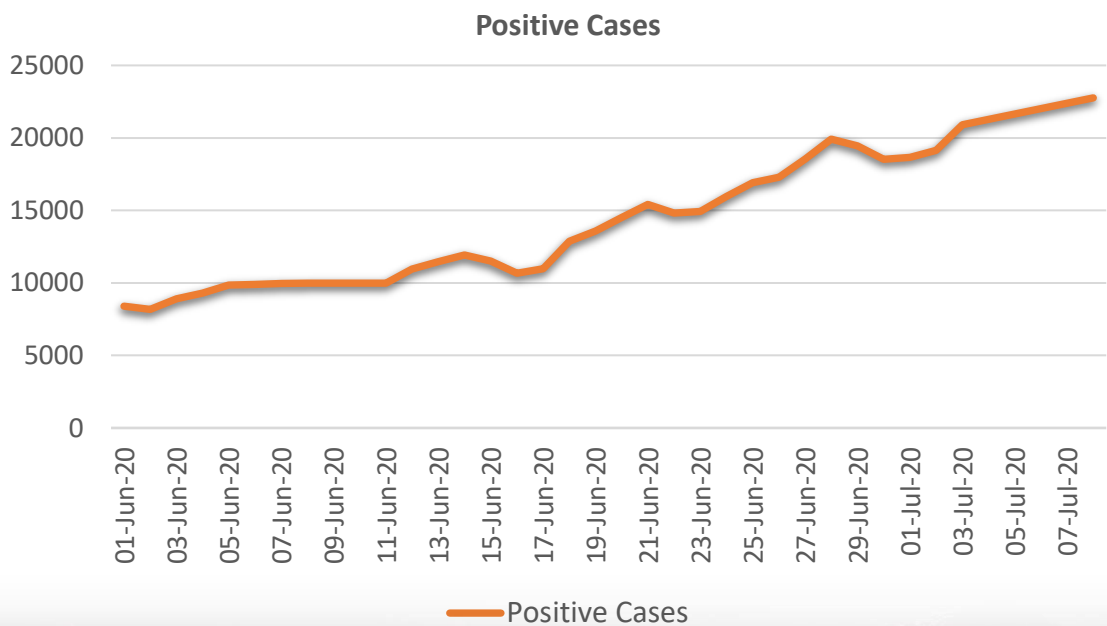

Covid - 19 Unlock 2.0



When the Government has announced unlocking of the country in three phases, citizens are getting anxious due to the growing number of COVID - 19 cases, according to a survey by Local Circle. The survey found that the lockdown 1.0 (March 25th) to Unlock - 1.0 (June 1st), there has been a 166 per cent rise in number of Indians feeling anxious and worried. People feel that enough testing is not being done by the Government due to large number of Cases post Unlock - 1.0. Some citizens are increasingly feeling that the positive cases being reported are been controlled by some local administrations and State Government by reducing the number of tests conducted so their districts or state doesn't have to report high number. When the curve in many countries has started to flatten, India is still witnessing record single day spikes in the number of patients. India has over taken Spain to become 4th worst- hit country by Covid -19, with numbers of infected crossing 7,70,500 cases.



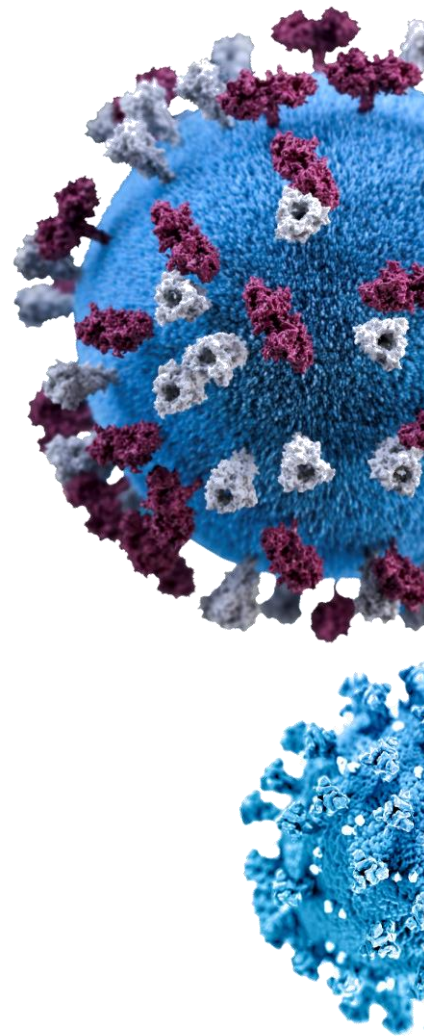
This survey says that Government needs to evaluate if Unlock 1.0 makes sense for every district or the high virus load districts in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Delhi, Karnataka and so on must be treated differently.

While the epidemic curve was controlled and near to flattening during the 70 days stringent lockdown in April and May, the number of Covid - 19 cases again started rising after the exit.

New guidelines have also been issued by the Union Home Ministry on Monday night for 'Unlock - 2.0' in the country. The guidelines issued for 'Unlock - 2.0 ' has come into effect from July 1st after the completion of 'Unlock - 1.0' on June 30th . We can experience a huge hike in positive cases on 03rd July 2020 of almost 20,903 after the 'Unlock -1.0'.

As per the new guidelines of Government's Unlock-2:

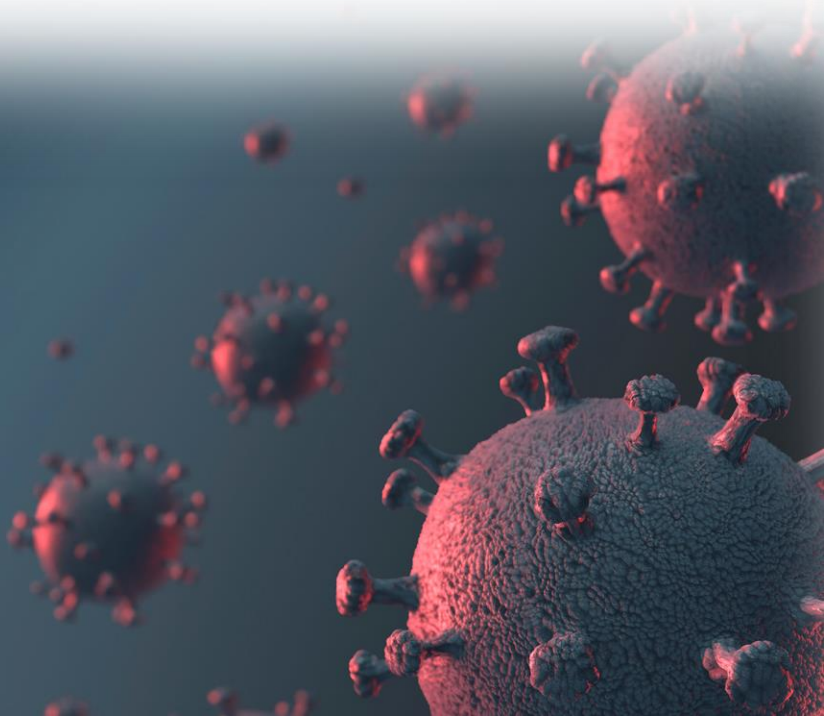
- The night check in time has been reached out from 10 am to 5 pm the nation over.
- Basic administrations to be excluded.
- School universities the nation over will stay shut until July 31st .
- Metro Rail, film corridors, rec centers, pools, and so on., additionally choose to stay shut by July 31st . Will be applicable in container zone till 31st July lockdown, just essential works permitted in the container zone.
- The rule of Unlock - 2.0 has been given to the States to distinguish the cradle zone outside the container zone, where the corona case is probably going to increment. The region organization can force important limitations in such places.
- The rules likewise state, "Training institutions of central and state governments will be permitted to work from July 15th , for which standard working technique (SOP) will be given by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT)."



"Infection imported from outside and located in urban areas concentrating metros first in first two months, then infection has moved in peripheral districts and small cities. This movement has given an impression in some areas that cases are decreasing in some areas and in other surge but this is movement of infections and population," said Dr Jugal Kishore, professor and head, department of community medicine, Safdarjung Hospital.

He said that the idea of this infection is capricious, no one comprehends what it might bring tomorrow. It might be conceivable that the cases increment in the coming days. On 23rd June, Delhi had the highest single day tally with over 4000 cases. Even after the decline Delhi is reporting over 2000 cases daily over the last week.

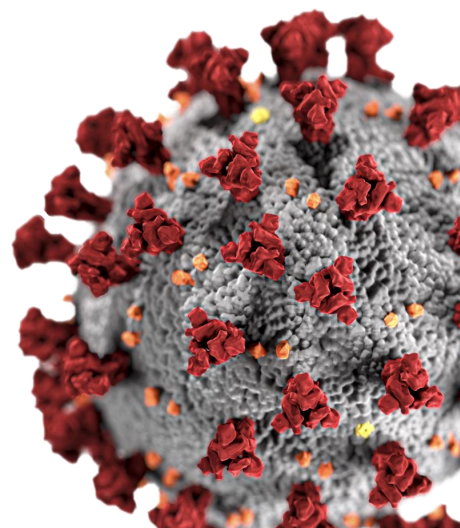
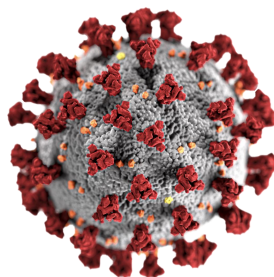
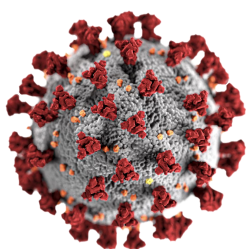
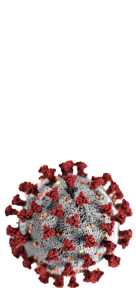
Also, Karnataka has seen a sharp ascent in Covid -19 cases since the time it opened state outskirts. Be that as it may, the quantity of nearby contaminations has ascended over the most recent fourteen days, inciting the specialists to get rid of a section in its day by day preparation determining the specific number of cases from out of state showing the chance of a network spread. The quantity of cases in Bengaluru has seen a sharp flood that has fueled fears if the B.S.Yediyurappa drove state government would backslide into another lockdown in the state's development capital.



Karnataka has breached the 28,877 Covid -19 case mark ahead of projections and is estimated to have at least 50,000 cases by mid of August, according to the government. The state government has already asked doctors to be mentally prepared to continue Covid -19 related work for another six months.

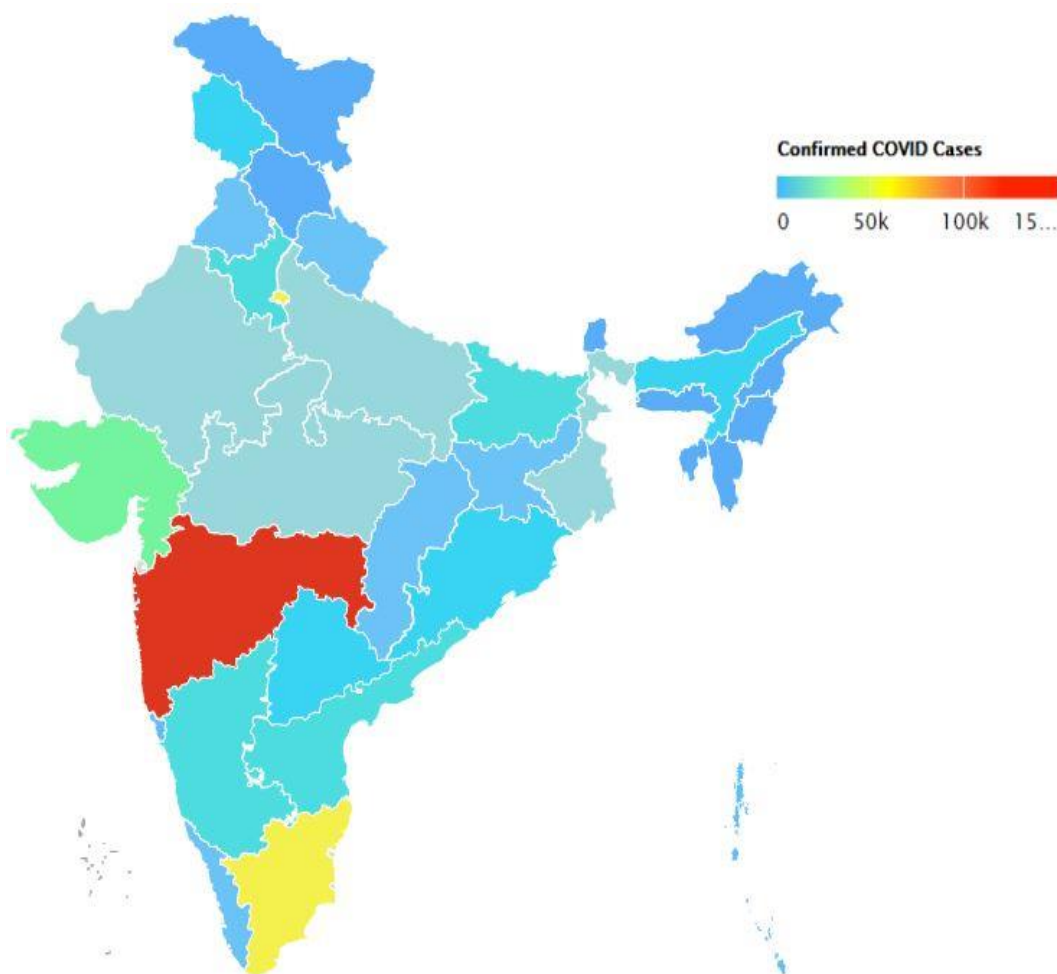
Health specialists have said that the quantity of cases will increment because of the beginning monsoon season that is likewise a season for flu. "There will be a more noteworthy number of Covid -19 cases as the flu season will come. There will be twofold issue. The cases that we are seeing presently are repositories of the lockdown. Not long after the development began, the cases additionally began expanding. We will additionally observe an expansion. The sickness keeps on being unusual,"

- A 21 days lockdown at this stage will not be enough to contain the virus spread.
- A quick resurgence of the outbreak will follow soon after lockdown is lifted.
- Possibility of likely transmission between three generations at Indian homes.
- In India, 15 -19 year old could be the most prominent carriers of the virus.
- In India, 60 - 64 year old are likely to suffer the highest mortality rate.
- Another alternative suggestion is increasing the speed of Vaccine trail in India.
- Increase labs in country along with proper care must be taken by the medical staff.

Currently, in India there are 4,77,572 recovered cases more than the active covid-19 cases so far taking the recovery rate to 62%. Presently, there are 2,71,841 active cases and all are under medical supervision, the union health ministry said in a statement. As on Wednesday July 8th, India recorded 7,70,585 covid-19 cases and 21,172 deaths and 1,07,40832 tests are done till date.

The testing lab network in the country is further strengthened. With 786 labs in the government sector and 314 private labs, there are as many as 1100 labs in the country.
